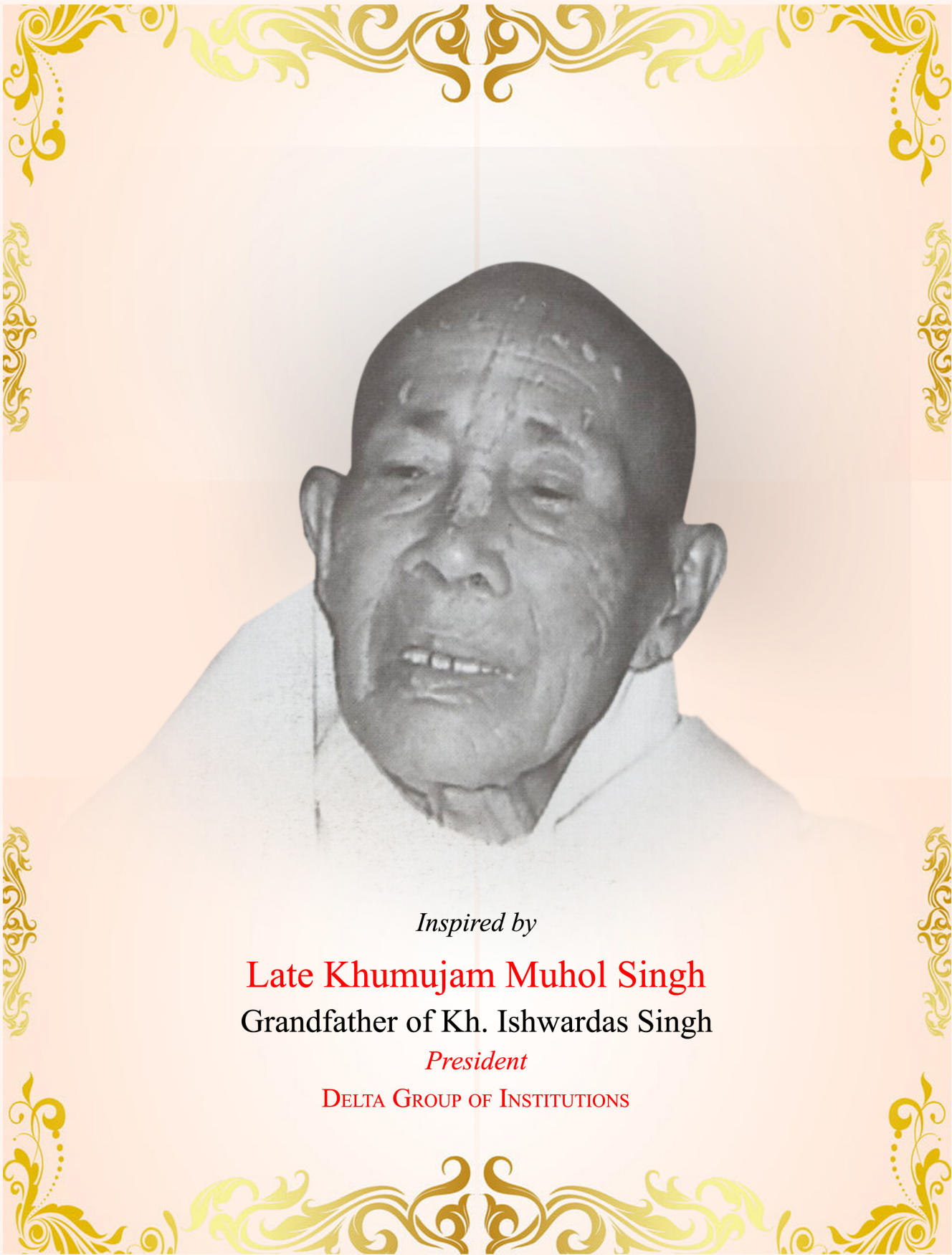

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Application form for admission

Application form along with the Prospectus can be obtained from the office of Delta Advance School (DAS) Kwakeithel, Imphal. Application forms can also be downloaded for the Delta Advance School (DAS) website : www.deltaadvanceschool.com at free, but at the time of submission it needs to pay an amount of Rs.150 only.

Mode of admission

Admission is done through screening and counselling only.

Submission of application form

Duly filled in application form along with the following documents should reach the office of the Delta Advance School (DAS) in time.

- i) Two self-attested copies of Mark sheets of HSLCE or equivalent exam.
- ii) Two self-attested copies of Admit Card of HSLCE or equivalent exam.
- iii) Two recent passport photos of the students.
- iv) Two copies of SC/ST/OBC/Minority Certificate.
- v) Two self-attested copies of Aadhaar.

Admit Card for Counselling

The office of Delta Advance School (DAS) will issue admit card for the counselling. Date, time and centre of the counselling will be intimated in the admit card.

Selection and Declaration of result

Selection of candidates for admission to class XI will be solely made on the basis of marks scored by the candidate in the screening. Results will be declared within 24 hours after the test.

Counselling

Counselling for admission of the selected candidates will be conducted on the date and time fixed by the office of Delta Advance School (DAS). The candidates are required to produce the original Certificate, Marks Sheets and Admit Card at the time of counselling.

The candidates should be accompanied by their Guardians/Parents at the time of the counselling. Any student who fails to appear at the time of the counselling for admission on given date shall not be considered for admission.

School Admission Fee

School admission fee and fee structure will be given at the time of counselling for admission.

Hostel Admission

The initial Hostel capacity is 60 seats for Boys and 80 seats for Girls. Admission to the Hostel is purely based on the merit i.e. 50% on the basis of selection test and 50% on the basis of the marks scored on their HSLCE or equivalent exam. But, 20% seats of the Hostel are reserve for the students residing beyond 20 kms or more from the school.

Hostel Fees

Hosteller's fee details will be given at the time of counselling for admission.

DAS Brilliance Award

DAS Topper Award

Rules & Regulations

1. Every student enrolled in the Delta Advance School (DAS) has to use only the School Bag issued by the DAS; if he/she fails to bring it, the institute will not allow him/her to enter the institute campus.
2. If a student is absent for more than a week continuously without prior written application with proper reason he/she will be summoned to the Principal's office along with his/her parent/guardians for explanation (reason). And if the absence continues for the next week also (seven days) he/she has to pay a penalty of half of the Admission fee to attend the normal classes further; otherwise he/she will be expelled from the school.
3. Every student who is enrolled in the DAS will have to appear each and every Examination (Test). If a student fails to appear an examination without prior & reasonable written information he/she has to pay a penalty of Rs.500/- for each absent exams (test). Whereas a student need to pay a penalty of Rs. 100/- for each failed subjects in an examination.
4. Students should reach the institute's premise 15 minutes before starting the class.
5. The parents can meet the Principal/Manager of the school for discussion/inquiry/school development / suggestion etc. or any other problems concerning their ward with prior appointment only.
6. Every student should maintain strict discipline inside and outside the school.
7. Students who are indiscipline, insubordination and show disrespect to any faculty members or staff are liable to be expelled from the school.
8. Smoking, chewing of betel nut, taking tobacco, alcoholic drinks consuming any short of drugs are strictly prohibited. A student found indulging in any of such habits are liable to be expelled from the school.
9. The students must keep the school building neat and clean.
10. If any of the enrolled student is selected in any of the entrance exam/academic exam/job related exam, the school has the right to publish his/her photograph in local daily etc.
11. In case of any dispute arising out of present terms and conditons, the decision of the school Management Committte (SMC) is final. No fee or part of the fees will be refunded in such cases.
- 12.If a student is failed in all the subjects continuously in 2(two) consecutive school examinations, he/she will be expelled from the school.
13. All the students are compulsory to wear school uniforms.
14. For an expelled student (for RR2, RR7, RR12, RR13); the school authority will consider their readmission after paying the admission fees again with due conselling along with their parents / guardians in some conditions.
